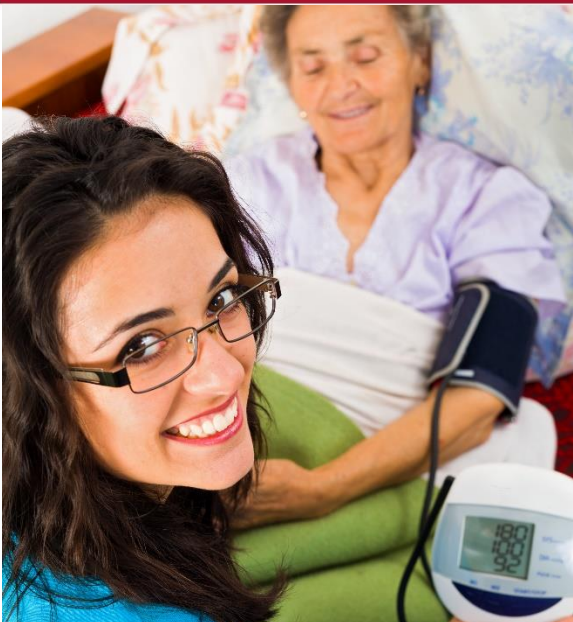


# Basic Nursing Assistant



## Training Purpose

## Time Requirements
